### **General and Practical Dowsing**

**Tutored by BSD registered tutor experienced in dowsing for general, practical, tangible targets, in weekend format or minimum of 12 hours tuition**

#### **Aim**

- To give comprehensive understanding and coaching in general, practical dowsing, with an emphasis on tangible, verifiable dowsing targets

#### **Objectives: At the end of the course, students will be able to:**

- Demonstrate a knowledge of the principles and practices of dowsing and of the circumstances in which dowsing is appropriate
- Dowsing for lost objects and concealed features, both on site and remotely
- Reliably access appropriate information, both on site and remotely

#### **Introduction & discussion**

Historical and contemporary uses of dowsing for identification and location of utilities – pipes, cables, drains, septic systems, storage tanks etc., use of dowsing in engineering contexts, use of dowsing for minerals, oil and gas, use of dowsing to locate missing objects. Endless variety of real, practical, tangible dowsing uses in everyday life, both at home and at work.

#### **Practical exercises**

Application of dowsing to real-time situations of need on ordinary daily basis.  
Use of different dowsing tools to find location and depth of available site dowsing targets around tuition venue.  
Use of different tools to assess direction and distance to missing objects  
Use of witness samples in site dowsing work

Discussion, demonstration and practical exercises

#### **Practical, legal and ethical considerations**

Discussion of common pitfalls when site dowsing and consideration of potential hazards on engineering sites  
Legal issues relating to site access and in mineral exploitation  
Ethical issues and psychic protection when site dowsing
